MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Josephites,

Greetings to all of you in this milestone event of our OBA!

As we celebrate our Centenary we express our thanks to all for having given us a very productive and blessed year. Without the continued support and encouragement received from all members of the Josephite Community, we would not have been able to celebrate this milestone year on this scale. Josephites, your participation and feedback is what drives us to aim higher each year, thank you!

My predecessor, Shashi Lewis '90 has, by his untiring efforts over the previous two years, laid the groundwork for the OBA to widen the range of our engagement with all segments that we serve-students, alumni and teachers and staff. I would like to place on record the debt that the OBA owes to him. Our partners and mentors, the Jesuit fathers, led by our Principal Fr Clifford Sequeira have always been cordial and encouraging with all of our initiatives and in the coming years we look forward to strengthening our relationship with them.

The OBA finances have strengthened this past year with continued contributions to our corpus funds, which have gone from Rs 4.25 crores to Rs 4.92 crores, an increase of about 15%. The OBA would like to record our thanks to Jimmy Anklesaria both for being the first donor using the Endowment Fund scheme, to set up the Anklesaria Family Endowment, but also for his continued wise counsel on many matters. Thank you Jimmy!

Fund raising has, in our Centennial year, started to build up momentum, and using the Endowment approach we plan to tap generous donors to give back more to their Alma Mater. We have for the first time worked out a strategy for fund raising and spending, and now have a well structured 5-year road map in place.

In coming years we plan on broadening and deepening our engagement with students in both academic and non academic, and relating to students, teachers and past students. Disbursals have touched Rs 40.00 lakhs. With Current enrollment of about 3600 students and the prevailing fee structure, the assistance offered by us can be increased, both in number and value. The successful mid day meal can also be expanded. In addition, staff healthcare premia inflation is increasing. For the first time this year we organized an outbound training programme for teachers and staff focussing on Team building, and feedback was very positive. We are confident that with your support, Meeting these increasing needs should not be a Difficult task, and plan to address this from the Year 2018-19.

Sports is part of the DNA of every Josephite and we have successfully leveraged on the sports platform connecting with to old students having different interests, both indoor and outdoor, with the help of generous sponsors. The detailed report of these events are contained in the report. I am glad to inform you that our collection of trophies in the OBA office has also significantly increased with generous Josephites sponsoring trophies for OBA events, outstanding sportsmen in school, as well as outstanding young sportsmen who have left school pursuing full time careers in sports. The OBA has also instituted a Sporting Wall of Fame which honours legendary Josephite sportsmen.

The Centenary edition of the Prestige SJBH SOBA golf tournament at Golfshire on January 13th, another marquee event for the OBA, has, thanks to our golf tournament team, led by Deepak Krishnankutty set a new benchmark. Ajit Nambiar's band performed to an enthusiastic audience ending with an entertaining and hugely rewarding auction of limited edition OBA memorabilia conducted by Sagar Muthappa '88. Our gratitude to Irfan, Rezwan and Noaman Razack for their participation and support, as well as all the other sponsors for their continuing support.

The quarterly OBA Calling Newsletter has been an effective means to disseminate information about events, improve our networking with Josephites worldwide and honour Josephite achievers. We take great pride in the fact that during this year St Joseph's is probably one of a handful of, if not the only school, having three serving Major Generals, Anil Dere '74, MN Devaya '78 and Bansi Ponnappa '79 - all three featured in successive issues of the Newsletter. Jyotinath Ganguly's dedication and effort has made our electronic outreach significantly more effective, by going out to increasing numbers, which many of you may have noticed. Our database is currently about 6000 strong and we are constantly updating it. The OBA Connects in Coorg, Cochin, Dubai, USA and Singapore have all been well organized and attended.

Our Centenary memorabilia on offer has been broadened. Well known illustrator Paul Fernandes '74 has generously contributed his talent for the cause, and our collectibles and limited editions bearing his easily identifiable and unique style having been well received. There has been a very strong and encouraging response and we look to your continuing support. We thank Franklin Antonat '88, Naren KN '06 Brian D'Lima '75 and Vivek George '04 for their assistance. Bharat Ram '94 has led The OBA Design team, and his posters and design skills have been widely appreciated.

The OBA's recent efforts initiated to provide a sporting platform for Josephites has been very successful and received with great enthusiasm. THE OBA LEVERAGED TECHNOLOGY DURING THE YEAR 2017-18

Technology has increasingly encompassed our lives over the recent past. The outreach of the OBA had been limited to a fairly static web site (sjbhsoba.net) that had been developed to primarily provide information to the Josephite community. The information that was being provided spanned news about upcoming OBA events, recently held OBA events, OBA Calendar of events, photographs, obituaries, accomplishments of Old Boys, and news from school.

There was a significant change in the online presence and outreach of the OBA during the year 2017-18. Keeping in mind that the charter of the OBA is to increase camaraderie among Josephites and to 'give back' to our alma mater, the Managing Committee resolved to leverage technology in a number of ways.

Social media platforms have been used to increase awareness of OBA events conducted in Bangalore and at Chapters worldwide, such as those at North America, Middle East and Singapore. The younger Josephite community has been addressed through Facebook and Instagram. For example, the drawing of lots for the Football and Hockey tournaments were broadcast live on Facebook and Instagram, and so were the finals of the tournaments.

The ability of the OBA to 'give back to our alma mater' is significantly dependent on the state of the financial corpus. The OBA has been able to increase the corpus by conducting several reunions and fund raising drives. Reunions such as the OBA Golf Tournament have been driven by technology for both marketing and fund raising. The OBA successfully executed fund raising through donations towards exclusive Centenary memorabilia that included art works by Paul Fernandes, limited edition Myra beverages, limited edition Amrut beverages and limited edition Zippo lighting devices. All the above initiatives were driven and supported by a strong technology platform.

For the first time, the web site of the OBA presented a dynamic interface to collect donations for several causes towards Old Boys, students, and teachers. The MC wishes to acknowledge the contributions of the Information Technology sub-committee of the Managing Committee of the OBA that made this happen. The key members included Daniel Prabhu (2006), Lawrence Taur (2004), Vivek George (2004), Jaya Prabhu (1999), Vikram Chugh (1992), Francis Satish (1991) and Jyotinath Ganguly (1975).

The IT sub-committee intends to further ramp up online presence and transactional capabilities of the OBA web site during the year 2018-19.

ACTIVITIES REPORT OF THE OBA 2017-18

1. The OBA finances have become stronger this past year with continued contributions to our corpus funds, which have increased from Rs 4.25 crores to Rs 4.92 crores, and our annual spend is currently approaching Rs 40 lakhs and growing. This has, in our Centennial year, started to build up momentum, and using the Endowment approach we plan to tap generous donors to give back more to their Alma Mater. We have revised our approach to fund raising and spending, and now have a well structured 5-year road map in place. In coming years we plan on broadening and deepening our engagement with students both in academic and non-academic activities.
2. With respect to academic scholarships we have disbursed Rs 11.00 lakhs to 100 students from disadvantaged backgrounds. With the current enrollment of about 3600 students and the prevailing fee structure, the assistance offered by us can be increased, both in number and quantum. We are confident that with your support this should not be a difficult task, and plan to address this from the year 2018-19.
3. The mid day meal scheme, aimed at providing lunch which was launched last year has continued successfully, and stabilized. We work in conjunction with the school's catering contractor who at a very reasonable cost, provides a hot lunch to 35 needy students.
4. Our support for students through the 6th edition of the OBA Buzz, the Literary and Cultural Fest saw enthusiastic participation, from all students. This is one of our flagship events and aimed at spotting and nurturing skills and talent in a wide range of individual and team activities. The level of participation was of a high level, with the final winner, St Patrick's House. In all there were 18 events covering Standard 5-12, the Best Manager event was a well attended one. The feedback from participants was both positive and encouraging. Thanks to all the MC members who gave generously of their time, especially Nandita, Naren, CS Rajan, Ian, Shashi, Jyoti and volunteers Cyrus, Mohit and Amrit who made this event a success.
5. The Innovation Lab in its third edition has seen good participation from students from Standard 7-9. The working models displayed to the judges were in most cases both innovative and ingenious. We welcome and invite more old students to volunteer their time in mentoring and judging since this can be a good stepping stone for future innovators.
6. The Career Fair this year, for Classes 10-12 has not yet been held due to a packed schedule, we hope to do this at an opportune time, in the near future with the help of Volunteers.
7. The Outbound training programme, a first for teachers and staff was conducted over multiple weekends. An experienced trainer who handled the sessions focused on improving communication skills, team work and team building. The OBA thanks Francis Satish for his efforts in coordinating and monitoring this initiative which was very well received by the participants.
8. As is customary the health insurance policy for the teachers was sponsored by the OBA, and we thank Sumir Hinduja for his untiring efforts.
9. Sports still occupies pride of place among bonding and fun activities, and this year was no different. The 2nd five a side football tournament held in the first Saturday of December was, building on the success of last year's inaugural event, an even more successful one. The turnout this year was larger, despite the rain that preceded it, the participation more enthusiastic, and with the OBA team assisted by Mr Shivaprakash it was an unqualified success. The prize distribution for the event was done at the Christmas party. The Saleh Ahmed 5 a side Rink hockey tournament in its second edition on March 18th was also a successful event. Being a one-day event, and having learnt the lessons from last year, we were able to conduct it with 10 teams participating with enthusiasm, once again with active assistance from Mr Shivaprakash. The inaugural OBA cricket tournament on with Jimmy Anklesaria as sponsor was also a grand success, with Sadanand Vishwanath, Fazal Khaleel and Shahvir Tarapore present to inaugurate it. Teams spanning the 1960's to post 2010 competed for glory.

99.4 Presentation of the OBA Lifetime Achievement Award: The OBA Lifetime Achievement Award for 2017 was presented to Dr. Gerard Aranha (batch of 1960). Mr. Santosh Naidu read out the citation. Born in Bangalore, Dr. Aranha studied in SJBHS and graduated in 1960. He completed his MBBS from Bangalore Medical College in 1969. He then went to the US for further studies and specialised in Surgical Oncology (pancreatic and oesophageal cancer). He has been associated with Loyola University, Chicago for 4 decades and has won a lot of accolades for his work. He was honoured by his Alma Mater, the Bangalore Medical College, in 2009. He was rated amongst the top 1% of US surgeons in 2011. Whilst receiving the award, Dr. Aranha thanked the OBA for the honour and said that he accepted it with humility. Quoting George Burns, he said that a speech should have a beginning and an end and both should be close to each other. He had a few words of advice for the younger generation:- there is no gain without pain; give more than you receive; time is better than money; create your own image and avoid negativity. He said that God put us on this earth for a specific purpose. All these values were taught in school. He said that he was amazed by the work done by the OBA (scholarships, Medclaim for the faculty etc) and congratulated the Association for the same. He expressed the fact that he was proud to be a Josephite and thanked everybody for conferring upon him this great honour.

99.5 **Presentation of the OBA award for Significant Achievement Award:**

1) **Prof. Rajeev Gowda** (1978)

Member of Parliament, Rajya Sabha

Born into an eminent political family (his father Shri M.V.Venkatappa was the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly and Chairman of the Legislative Council in Karnataka), he completed his BA from St. Joseph's College, Bangalore. He has several degrees from prominent US universities. From 2000 to 2014, he was Professor of Economics and Social Sciences at the IIM, Bangalore. He has been a Director on the Central Board of the Reserve Bank of India and a Carnegie Council Global Ethics Fellow. In 2014, he was elected to the Rajya Sabha as a Member of Parliament representing the State of Karnataka. He is currently the Chairperson of the All India Congress Committee's Research Department.

2) **Mr Nandan Kamath** (1993)

Rhodes Scholar and Sports Lawyer

Nandan Kamath gave up his dream of being a professional cricketer and pursued a career in law. A graduate of the National Law School of India University (NLSIU) in the year 2000, Nandan has been a recipient of the Rhodes Scholarship. After completing his BCL in Law and M.Sc. in Economic and Social History from Balliol College, University of Oxford in 2002, he went on to pursue his Masters in Harvard Law School. On returning to India, he founded his own law firm, The Law Offices of Nandan Kamath (Law NK), which is one of the leading law firms in the country in the field of Sports, Media, Technology and IPR Laws. He is also a Trustee at GoSports Foundation, a non-profit that he co-founded in 2008. Its vision is to empower young athletes and enable them to achieve their Olympic and Paralympic dreams.

99.6 **Presentation of the Staff Appreciation Award:**

1) **Mrs. Tarini Wilson**

Nandita Chandrashekhara placed on record the services rendered by Mrs. Wilson over a period of 30 years. Mrs. Wilson replied that she was deeply touched and overwhelmed with gratitude. She said that she had the honour and privilege of serving under 5 principals. The school boys have made her stint at SJBHS very memorable. She concluded by saying that it was nice to see the strong bonding amongst the Old

Boys which will endure for posterity.

2) **Mr. Sundar Ramana**- He thanked the school, the Principal and the OBA for the award.

99.7 **The Presidential Address:** The President, Mr. Shashi Kiran Lewis, thanked the Almighty and said that the previous year was a very eventful and fulfilling year. He thanked all the Old Boys for the support and encouragement he received during his second year as President of the OBA. The year gone by was a mix of the old traditional events along with a few new initiatives. He said that the financial corpus had grown from Rs.3.19 crore to Rs. 4.25 crore, a growth of 18.56 %. Out of this total growth of the corpus, the scholarship fund has grown significantly from Rs. 1.21 crores to Rs. 1.69 crores resulting in a growth of 40%. The other funds have grown by 11% and currently stand at Rs.2.21 crores. He said all this could not have happened without the continued generosity of Old Boys and he was grateful for the same.

The Mid-Day meal was launched this year. This is an initiative of the Batch of 1992, which raised a corpus of 16 lakh rupees. This programme benefits 34 needy students enabling them to get a hot meal in school.

A new initiative, the JOSEXCEL (Josephite Sporting Excellence Celebratory Lunch) was held on 3rd December, 2016. Its objective is to celebrate the achievements of the students of Std X who have represented the school in various sporting activities and also to honour Old Boys who have gone on to represent the country in sports. The parents of the students being honoured were also invited for the lunch. President expressed his gratitude to Mr George Olapally for taking this initiative forward and for also incorporating a corpus fund for this purpose.

Another new initiative taken by Mr. Franklin Antonat is the OBA Riders group which has brought together Old Boys with a passion for riding. The group has been very active, starting with a ride to Coorg.

The OBA Riders group led to the birth of the OBA Design Sub-Committee. The riders required digital posters to be made on a regular basis and a few of them who were professionally trained volunteered to get this done. The President thanked Daniel Prabhu and Bharath for the same.

A Digital Payment Gateway was set up by Deepak Krishnakutty (1979) and Jyotinath Ganguly. Now

Jyotinath Ganguly launched the Innovation Lab targeted at the students of the VII to XII standards. It will conclude with the science exhibition scheduled to be held during mid-November of 2017.

The OBA Career Fair was held on 24th August, 2017 for the students of Std X and XII. 12 career streams were covered and Jyotinath Ganguly took the initiative forward.

The President thanked Jyotinath Ganguly for his contributions in bringing out the OBA Calling (quarterly newsletter of the OBA) by email.

The Middle-East Chapter of the OBA announced that the first edition of the Dubai Connect would be held from 2nd to 4th November, 2017. It would be the first international connect of the OBA.

The President expressed his gratitude to all the Old Boys who had helped out with various events especially the following:

Naren, Reo and Vivek for their efforts in organising the Inter-batch Football tournament.

Francis Satish for spearheading the organisation of the Christmas Dinner.

George Ollapally, Deepak Krishnankutty, Sagar Muthappa, Joseph Ollapally, Arjun Unnikrishnan and team for their tireless effort towards making the annual Golf tournament a success.

George Ollapally and Santosh Naidu for organising the JOSEXCEL Lunch.

Naren, Reo, Vivek George and Sandeep Somesh for organising the Inter-batch Hockey tournament.

Naren, Vivek George, Ashwin Leyland, Nandita Chandrashekhar, Cyrus D'Lima, Amrit Sodhi, Harikartik Ramesh and Siddhanth Swamy for organising the OBA Buzz.

The President also thanked all the sponsors and

advertisers for having supported the OBA in its various activities through the year.

And whilst concluding, he expressed his deep gratitude to Brain D'Lima who has been a pillar of support and selflessly served the OBA for many years and continued to do so.

99.8 Principal's Address: - The Principal, Fr. Clifford Sequeria, warmly welcomed all the Old Boys. He said that he was happy for that the OBA had contributed significantly to the school. He appreciated the various OBA initiatives- the OBA Buzz has been a very good source to unearth new talent in the school and provided opportunities to many students who would otherwise not have had a platform to showcase their talents. The Innovation Lab is set to increase their skills of critical thinking whilst the Career Counselling will help them in thinking about their goals in a more focused manner. The Mid-Day Meal scheme (especially the Batch of 1992) helped needy students. The support extended to sports by providing breakfast for the school hockey team and by honouring students who excelled in sports during JOSEXCEL awards, was much appreciated by Father Principal. The OBA scholarships for needy students and the insurance scheme for the staff continued to be a very important source of support to the School. He appreciated the new initiative of the OBA to conduct Outbound programs for the whole staff in separate batches to help them become effective teachers. The School is not only very grateful for all that the OBA does but also very proud of this Association which continues to demonstrate its unwavering loyalty and affection for its Alma Mater.

The Principal then went on to give a brief report of the activities and achievements of the school during the year. The addition of an extra section resulted in 3413 students being on the rolls when the school reopened in June 2017. It was with pride that he announced the excellent results-100% results with all the students passing - in the Std 10 and 12 Board Exams 2017. In Cricket the school had a number of successes to its credit. In the Cottonian shield, it was a double bonanza for the school as it emerged winner in both U-16 and U-14 categories and carried home both the trophies. In the KSCA tournament the Under 16 team were the Runners up. In Hockey the Under-16 team won the Vidyashilp interschool tournament and the Under-14 category were the winners in the Fr Eric Vaz

Memorial tournament. The school innovation team were the national level winners of Teenovators 2016. The team developed a fully working model of the Sound Assisted Fire Extinguisher that uses low frequency sound waves to extinguish fires. It won a 5 Lakh rupees' cash prize and much media recognition. In the finals of the prestigious Frank Anthony Memorial All India Debate held in Lucknow in early July, the school was placed second at the national level. In a news and current affairs related quiz conducted by India Today Network two of the students made it through to the quarterfinals in Delhi. At the YMUN (model United Nations) in China the school delegation was adjudged the 'Best Delegation' and the delegates won several Best Delegate awards. The school has been conducting Outreach programs for the students so that they are sensitised to the hardships of others. Some of the students and teachers undertook a trip to a Jesuit school in Manvi in Raichur where they got a first-hand look and feel of the plight of the marginalized sections of our society. A Religious Harmony Week was conducted in the third of week of August. It was very successful and the school plans to make it an annual feature. Four of our Old Boys readily accepted the invitation to address the students on this issue through a panel discussion which proved to be very thought provoking and stimulating. The School has also strived to continuously upgrade its facilities and introduce new features in its academic and non-academic program. Very recent additions include a Digital Library, renovated Office, Solar heating, waste management system, addition of a lift [which is in progress], more classrooms, CCTV cameras, Sports equipment, redesigned website, upgrading of infrastructure in the Staff rooms, more competitions, increased number of Clubs including Sporting ones etc.

In conclusion, Father Principal conveyed his best wishes to all the Old Boys. He prayed that the Patron Saint of the school will always be by their side to protect them. As the School song says "My hand and Gods..." may your thoughts words and actions always be guided by the Almighty.

The President - Shashi Kiran Lewis, the Secretary- Brian D'Lima and Father Principal then released the Centenary Logo of the OBA.

99.9 To confirm the Minutes and Proceedings of the 98th Annual General Meeting held on 4th September, 2016: The President asked if the Minutes could be taken as approved. Joe D'Mello proposed and Jayanth Kapadia seconded the motion.

The President formally invited all Old Boys for the OBA Centenary celebrations in 2018. He welcomed suggestions for new events. He said that the OBA was probably set up in 1912 or 1913 but the first recorded meeting was in 1918. There are no records prior to that year.

99.15(A) With the permission of the Chair, Oscar Menezes (1959) thanked the OBA for helping out when faced with a medical emergency in November 2016.

99.15(B) With the permission of the Chair, Greg de Nazareth said that all Old Boys should come up with new ideas to celebrate the Centenary Year.

99.15(C) With the permission of the Chair, Jimmy Anklesaria said that the focus of this celebration is the OBA. To organise many events, numerous sub-committees would be required. He said fund raising would be required on a massive scale. He wondered whether to bring out a history of the OBA book or a coffee table book. The history book would contain more textual matter whereas the coffee table book would have more photos. He said dates of all events should be announced well in advance. One should look at the big picture. The focus should be on the OBA itself. He suggested that a minimum of one week be kept for the celebrations. He was saddened to hear of the closing of the Australian Chapter of the OBA.

The President thanked Jimmy for his suggestions and said that they would be considered.

99.15(D) With the permission of the Chair, Oscar Menezes suggested that a time capsule be kept somewhere in the school to be opened 50 years later. The President felt that it was a good idea.

99.15(E) With the permission of the Chair, Noel de Nazareth enquired whether any dates had been fixed for the celebrations. The President replied that the first weekend of September, 2018 would be the highlight. Noel requested for a formal OBA Ball.

99.15(F) With the permission of the Chair, M.V.Nagaraj (1968) suggested the use of high end technology especially during the photo session.

99.15(G) With the permission of the Chair, Arjun Nambisan suggested that something should be done to ensure continuity as the Managing Committee

changes every year. It takes about 2 months for the new committee to settle down.

99.15(H) With the permission of the Chair, Jayanth Kapadia volunteered his services if the Secretary required any assistance during the Centenary Year.

99.16 **Vote of Thanks:** Ian Lewis proposed the Vote of Thanks. He thanked Father Principal, Shashi Lewis, Brian D'Lima and all the Old Boys for having come for OBA Day. He also expressed his gratitude to all the patrons and sponsors who contributed in the past year. He placed on record his appreciation of the services rendered by the outgoing Managing Committee.

99.17 **To elect Office Bearers for the year 2017-2018:** Mr. Greg de Nazareth was nominated as the Election Officer. The following were elected un-opposed

THE CHANGING FACE OF ST. JOSEPH'S (1858-2018)

A former principal, Fr. Hedwig Da Costa, S.J., once wrote that the history of English Education in India is almost contemporaneous with the institution of St. Joseph's Boys' High School in Bangalore. Few, however, will be aware of the number of avatars that this hallowed institution has passed through. Here are a few glimpses of the glorious past of St. Joseph's.

The Beginnings of St. Joseph's Seminary (1841-1858)

Among the early Christian institutions in Bangalore was St. Patrick's Church (1841), in the premises of which a small seminary for the training of Catholic clergy seems to have been opened in 1846. The seminary (which, some speculate, may have been where the Catholic Club presently stands) was run by priests belonging to the French Foreign Mission (the MEP Fathers) who, a few decades previously, had taken over the Jesuit mission in Mysore. In 1854, on the arrival of the Good Shepherd Sisters from France, the seminarians gave up their quarters and shifted to a new location at St.

John's Hill (then called Mootocherry), where new quarters were built for them the same year. With the establishment of Madras University in 1857, it became possible to send up students for the matriculation examination. A few months later, in 1858, the first European boarders were received at the seminary.

From Seminary to College (1858-1884)

In 1863, through a Government grant, a large piece of ground (the present St. Germain's School) was given to the Mysore Mission. Records are found of the main house being completed in 1865, and other simple buildings being erected in the 1860s and early 1870s (these buildings are no longer in existence). The institution at this stage consisted of a combination of seminary, orphanage, boarding school and college. It taught students of the first, second, third, fourth and matriculation classes, of which the first class was kept in the front verandah, the second, third and fourth were taught together in a study room (which was very disturbing to both teachers and students) and the matriculation class had

a separate room.

In 1875, the orphans were shifted to St. Patrick's Orphanage. In 1882, through the efforts of the new rector, Fr. Jacques Vissac, St. Joseph's came to be affiliated to Madras University as a Second Grade College, and classes began on January 15, 1883. At that stage, the School had around 150 pupils, both European and Indian. In 1884, the first two students completed their First Arts (F.A.) course, bringing pride and joy to the institution. For the next four decades, the institution was to be known as St. Joseph's College.

From St. John's Hill to Museum Road (1884-1898)



The indefatigable Fr. Vissac next set about building a elegant granite edifice more suited to a full-fledged college. The vast pillared structure – now St. Germain's High School – was completed by around 1883 and had a length of around 250 feet. By 1887, there were 5 European and 8 Indian teachers at the School, which now boasted 413 pupils of whom 53 were

boarders.

But barely a decade later, Fr. Vissac had realised that a more centrally located school would be able to serve a larger segment of society. In 1893, accordingly, a plot of land known as Rocklands, located on Museum Road, was purchased, and the foundation of the new college was laid. To limit expenditure, it was built according to a simpler design than the old college, with massive square pillars instead of the elegant round columns. In January 1898, the new building – which was to serve the School and boarding for the next century – was opened, with 100 boarders and 89 day scholars. The students at St. John's Hill were shifted to the new complex, and the vacated building became the residence of the Bishop of Mysore. St. Germain's High School was founded on the premises in 1944.

St. Joseph's Indian, European and College Sections

Fr. Vissac had vehemently opposed the segregation of European and Indian students. However, tensions had

arisen between the two communities, in addition to which the colonial policy mandated that the privileges granted to the “European” school should be withdrawn if the Indian students exceeded 5% of the total number. This would probably have resulted in grave financial stress and possible closure of the School. So the priests reluctantly consented to this separation as the lesser of two evils, and St. Joseph’s Indian High School was formally separated from the European section in 1904. St. Joseph’s continued to be called a College. In 1910, the High School system was introduced, after the old F.A. programme was suspended. The surviving School Annuals date from this period onwards. The Indian School moved to the building which later became St. Joseph’s PU College.

By 1920, the School had around 435 pupils of which 232 were boarders and 203 day scholars. It was perhaps the largest European educational institution in India at that point. The institution had been greatly strengthened, and the full-fledged Old Boys’ Association also dates from this period. As a reminder of the sacrifice of Josephites during the

First World War, the War Memorial was installed in front of the School building in 1921. At this point, the administration began developing the New Fields grounds on what is now Vittal Mallya Road, originally purchased in 1908. A major reorganisation of the institution took place on July 4, 1925, when the School and College administrations were separated, with Fr. Vanpeene as the principal of the School. The College building was completed in 1925 and BA Classes commenced from July 1926. Another important change was that St. Joseph’s began employing lady teachers for the primary section from 1928 onwards. The elegant tiled roof of the chapel was also completed in 1928.

From SJEHS to SJBHS (1937-1968)

St. Joseph’s was now widely recognized as one of the finest schools in India. But during the 1930s, the MEP fathers began the process of handing over much of their mission work to other organisations of priests and

religious. The Jesuits, who were already well established in India, had the experience and the personnel to take on the responsibility of running St. Joseph’s. With much heartache, the MEP Fathers moved out of the institution that they had nurtured from its earliest beginnings, and by June 1, 1937, Fr. Joseph Coelho took charge as principal of St. Joseph’s Indian High School, while Fr. L. Proserpio became the first Jesuit principal of St. Joseph’s European High School. Within a few years, he was followed by the first Indian principal, the much loved Fr. E. J. Jacques, who was to serve two terms.

The Jesuit ideals of integrity, concern for the poor, and excellence in the fields of academics, sports and extra-curricular activities, stood the School in good stead during



the Independence years and beyond. In particular, the School successfully integrated students of different communities, of varying linguistic and religious backgrounds, and of diverse economic strata, resulting in a sense of camaraderie that would endure long beyond their schooldays. The Cambridge examinations were

gradually phased out, and there was a period of transition first to the Anglo-Indian High School Exams and then to the ICSE and ISC system which continues to this day. The ISC batches (Stds. 11 and 12) were discontinued from the early 1970s, but returned a few decades later. A greater emphasis was now laid on Hindi (and, in the 1980s, Kannada) as the second language. Finally, the School itself was renamed, changing its identity in 1968 [exactly 50 years ago] from St. Joseph’s European High School to the much more appropriate St. Joseph’s Boys’ High School.

The Final Years of the Old School Building (1968-2001)

The major changes of the 1980s included the change in the beginning of the Academic Year of ICSE Schools (which now began in June rather than January), the introduction of computers in education as well as in school administration, and, significantly, the closure of the boarding in 1987. The discontinuation of the boarding

provided the School with additional space for classrooms and other facilities. However, it was noted that the structure of the building itself was weak in places. By the early 1990s, certain portions of the upper storey were becoming unusable due to safety concerns. It was estimated that the ground floor too would last just around 50-60 years more. At this point, the Jesuit community considered shifting the School to a different location. The OBA, however, came up with a different proposal, requesting the Jesuits to preserve the School at its current location on Museum Road, in return for which Old Boys from across the globe would provide the School with financial support to rebuild the entire structure. After due consideration, Fr. Michael John (then Principal), and Fr. Ronnie Prabhu (then Rector), agreed that this was the best possible solution, and there began the immense effort of demolishing the 100 year old school building and putting up in its place, a beautiful, modern structure that elegantly captured the spirit of the old while providing for the changed requirements of the 21st century.

The New St. Joseph's (2001-present)

The construction project was taken up in phases, beginning from the West Wing (inaugurated on August 31, 2002) and proceeding rapidly to the East Wing (inaugurated on December 27, 2003) and finally the central administrative block (inaugurated in June 2006). Special care was taken to provide a spiritually uplifting and aesthetically pleasing chapel, albeit at a different location, near the East Wing. The new chapel was blessed on March 7, 2004. The Old Boys made a significant contribution in terms of their financial donations as well as their advice and technical inputs. Over the next few years, the new building was provided

with advanced facilities such as plasma television screens in the classrooms, and, most importantly, the Loyola Sports Complex, inaugurated as recently as September 5, 2015. The ISC was reintroduced and for the first time, girls were admitted to Stds. 11 and 12. In 2018, the School held 3750 students and had a total staff strength of 137.

St. Joseph's has truly come a long way since its earliest beginnings as a seminary on St. John's Hill. However, the ethos and the spirit have always remained constant, and the values that the MEP Fathers strove to impart have been greatly strengthened under the able leadership of the Jesuit Principals. St. Joseph's has always aimed at excellence – in the classroom, on the sports field, and in all extra-curricular activities – and this has been reflected in the many brilliant success stories we have seen among our Old Boys. To that must be added the constant emphasis on the formation of character – to build people of integrity, that the world can rely on. But the underlying aim of the School – one that has been reflected in the personal and professional lives of generations upon generations of Josephites – is to inspire and motivate the young to be men and women for others, people who will be

concerned about the poor, the weak and the marginalized, and who will ultimately contribute towards building a better world and a warmer, more compassionate human family.

As we thank our Alma Mater that nurtured these values in us, and as we thank the OBA that binds us together as one Josephite Family, may we resolve that this spirit that has made St. Joseph's truly fortunate and blessed among schools, will never diminish or disappear from our midst.
