MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Old Boys and Girls



My warm wishes to all of you and hope all of you are keeping good health and prosperity.

It has been six years since I joined this Management Committee and spent four years (across three terms) as the Joint Treasurer and the final two years as President of this prestigious alumni association. Over this period and working with two extraordinary Presidents, from whom I have learnt a lot, and with a wonderful management committee, I have been blessed to witness several changes at the school. During this period of six years, the school has overcome the challenges of covid, completed the construction of the new block, double basement parking, school grounds and upgrades to the auditorium. The number

of students has also crossed 3700 in academic year 2025-26 and corresponding growth in the teaching and support staff. The school also has had a new Principal appointed in 2025-26 academic year, Father Norwin Pereira and continues to build on the legacy of the past Principal, Father Sunil Fernandes. The OBA is grateful to both the past and present principals for their unwavering support to the causes of the OBA and collaborative approach to working with the OBA. The school accounts team has been handling all the accounting entries of the SJBHS OBA accounts since 2019-20 and we are very grateful for their support.

The OBA also has grown in terms of the number of activities that are conducted and the impact of these activities. I am very happy to report that your alumni association has in the past year spent over Rs. 1.50 crore, which is the largest spend in one year, towards creating a meaningful impact for the school.

I am very grateful to the management committees over the years for demonstrating the fact that if a process is put in place, then the outcomes have a high chance of being delivered with the same consistency year after year. The management committee has documented handbooks for each of the activities of the OBA ranging from finance, sports, cultural and operational so that future MCs can benefit from the learnings over the years and continue to edit and modify such documents. The presence of two full time resources at the OBA office also help to maintain the continuity of the OBA events.

I am also very happy to report that through the additional funds raised via the Annual Josephite Run, the SJBHS OBA is presently meeting the entire premium requirement for the Teachers Insurance Program, despite the steep increases in Insurance Premiums.

Through the continued additional contributions of the Loyola Scholarship Program, the OBA is contributing to at least 25% of the total annual scholarship outlay of the school.

New Initiatives like the SJBHS OBA Forum are in the early days of growing into a larger platform where Josephites can benefit from interactions / connections with fellow Josephites across various verticals. With over 2000 requests from Josephites across batches to be part of various forums, this initiative is reaching the critical thresholds required to have enough members to deliver the required benefits to the members of the OBA Josephite Forums.

I am very grateful to the OBA Community for giving me this opportunity to serve the alma mater. I would like to especially thank all the members of the management committee alongside whom I have served for their guidance, teamwork and camaraderie.

Wishing the future Management Committee's all the very best and I am sure that the OBA will continue to grow in strength and impact over the years to come.

ACTIVITIES OF THE OBA – 2024 - 25



The OBA MC term 2024–25 commenced with the Managing Committee for the year assuming office on September 1, 2024. During this period, the MC has endeavored to strengthen our ties with the Josephite community and extend meaningful support to our alma mater.

The year has been marked by a series of events, programs, and initiatives aimed at fostering stronger connections among Old Boys, creating opportunities for networking and camaraderie, and contributing to the holistic development of students and staff of St Joseph's Boys' High School. Each activity was planned with the twin objectives of honoring our legacy and serving our school community in the spirit of *Fide et Labore*.

1. The Blue & White Ball 2024 was held on 31st August, 2024, was a huge success, with over 230 attendees. This was held at The Chancery Pavilion and all had a smashing time with great music and amazing food.
2. The OBA Day on 1 September, 2024 began with a Mass celebrated by Fr. Daniel Fernandes the new Rector and concelebrated by Fr. Sunil Fernandes, the principal of SJBHS who preached a meaningful homily. This was followed by the laying of the wreath at the War Memorial, unfurling of the School Flag and singing of the School Anthem. At the A.G.M. the Lifetime and Significant achievement awards were given out, after which the main Meeting began. The meeting was followed by the election of the new Managing Committee and the traditional camaraderie, which went on over the course of lunch.
3. The plaque ceremony announcing the 'Razack Family Block' was unveiled on Saturday, 7th September 2024 by Old Boys Mr. Irfan Razack (1968 Batch) and Mr. Rezwan Razack (1970 Batch). This was a tribute to the family for the donation towards the new project – additional classrooms, double basement and playground. Heartfelt Gratitude to the Razack Family for their donation of ₹ 5 Crores to SJBHS.
4. The OBA (Old Boys' Association) contributed INR. 1 Crore to SJBHS towards the ongoing building project playground with double basement and additional classrooms block. This was proposed at the AGM by the MC and seconded by the general body. Heartfelt Gratitude to the OBA for this wonderful gesture. In addition, the Bath of 1968 decided to transfer INR. 25 lakhs from their Batch fund to school for the same purpose.
5. The Chennai Connect was held on 13 October 2025 at the Officers Training Academy (OTA), graciously hosted by Lieutenant General Michael A. J. Fernandez, the current Commandant of OTA. The day began with a guided visit to the OTA Museum and campus, followed by refreshing juice at the refectory. Guests were then treated to some delightful live music by Fabian, before enjoying a leisurely lunch together. Mr. Irfan Razack (1968 Batch) also played a few rounds of golf during the tournament. This was followed by a fellowship dinner.
8. The OBA Christmas Dinner was held on December 6th, 2024. We had 250-275 people attending including Staff coordinators, retired teachers, the entire Jesuit Nivas and many youngsters. Many thanks to all those who attended the event.
9. The second edition of the Josephite Run was organized in association with the PTA. The event was held on 19th January, 2025 with Rahul Dravid, Anup Sridhar and Anil Aldrin being the face of the event and saw a participation of over 3,000 people, including running enthusiasts, students, their families, old boys, girls and many others ran for a noble cause.

Students who represented the school in various sports and those who excelled in other disciplines outside the school were honored with a lapel pin and certificate. The students were

Hundreds of students participated across 7 amalgamated disciplines and over 300 took part in the final 5 days across events. The participation in the all events far exceeded all expectations. 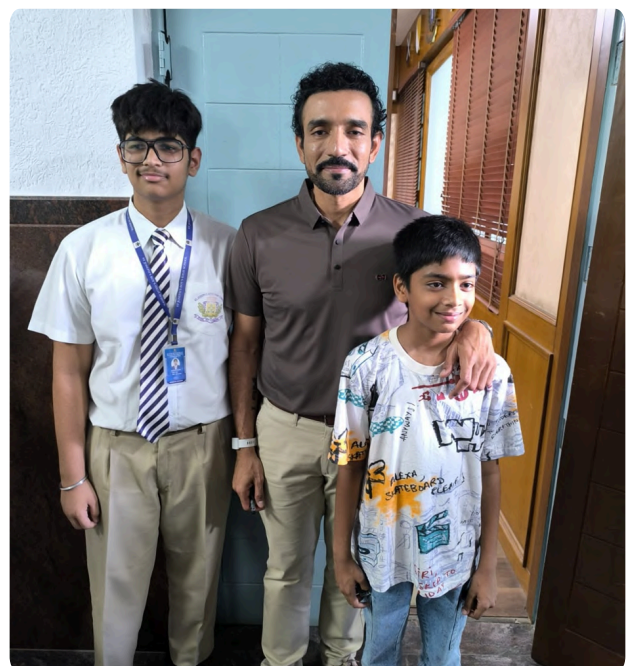

105.4 The Presidential Address

Mr. Aditya Kaura began by saying that it was the initiatives of past Presidents that was bearing fruit today. He went on to elaborate on this:

- Corpus Funds have grown to Rs. 10 crores
- On the Equity exposure front we are very close to reaching our limits. He thanked Jayesh and Mark for their support.
- Teachers' Insurance Fund – Each Teacher is now covered for Rs. 3 lakhs. The Fund was well supported by the Josephite Run.
- Scholarship Programme – Over 1 crore is given out in scholarships supporting about 100 students by the school of which the OBA has contributed to approximately 25%.
- The Mid-day meal outlay has increased from Rs.45/- to Rs 60/- per child.
- The Awards Funds continue thanks to specific donors and batches.

He then said that we now need to deploy the funds we have. The focus needs to shift to what we can do for the school.

He stated that the Association had seen windfall returns over the last year. These gains will be allocated in proportion of opening balance of the year to each of the end use corpus funds (as and when the gains are realized).

He said that we should not forget our focus on the Old Boys themselves for whom the annual activities still continue:

- Football, Hockey, Cricket, Basketball, Swimming and Golf Tournaments, which are well attended across batches.
- Connects across cities and geographies
- The Christmas Dinner Celebration and annual Blue and White Ball
- Distribution of merchandise
- Regular Social Media updates, plus the OBA Calling and Splice
- Forums to get Josephites connected with other Josephites

He concluded by thanking Fr. Principal for his outstanding support, Fr. Rector, the people who run the Accounts, MC Members and all Members of the General Body.

Fr. Sunil Fernandes said it was wonderful to be a part of this Josephite family. He spoke about his visit to the USA and the people he had met there.

He then went on to talk about the on-going project in School – the double basement and additional block. He appealed to all to support the Project.

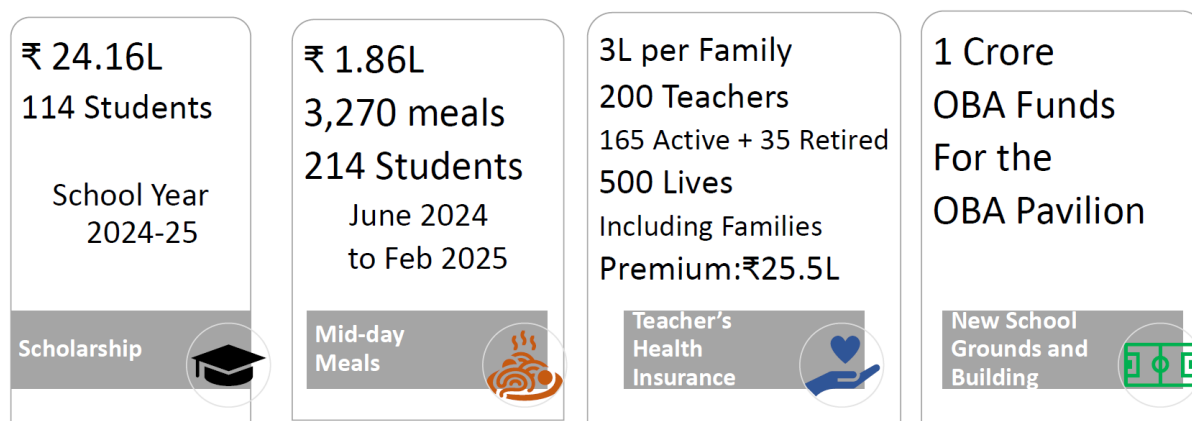

With the support of our OBA community, the **Mid-day Meal Scheme** currently:

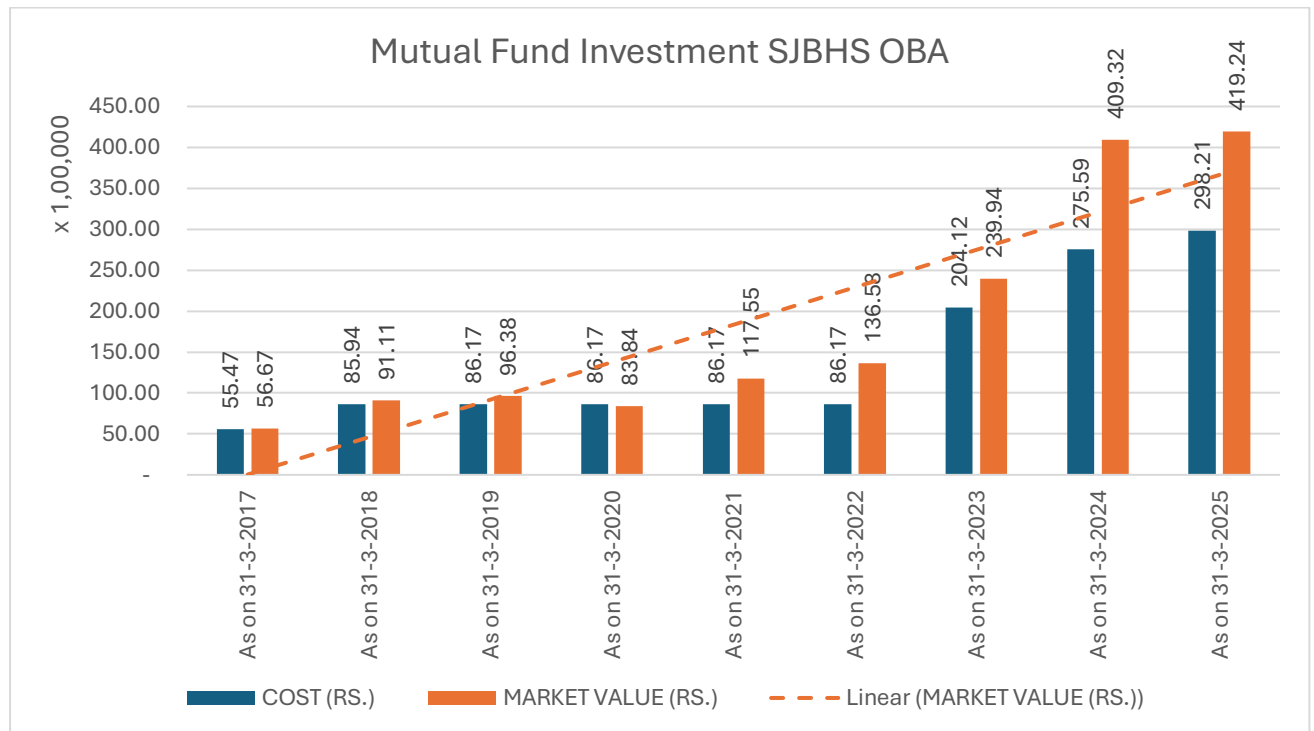
- Supports an average of 24 students per month.

With the help of support of our OBA community, The **Teachers' Health Insurance**:

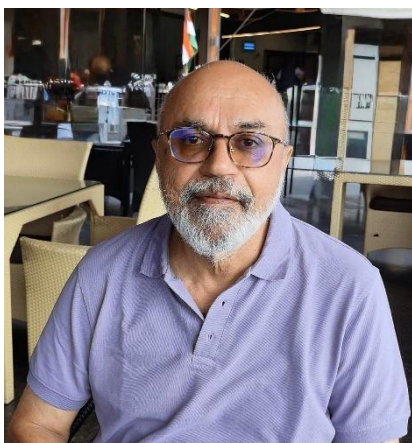
- Covers a total of 497 individuals, including teachers and their family members.

Gurmeet Singh Randhawa

Alumnus – St Joseph's Boys' High School, Class of 1969

Gurmeet Singh Randhawa spent his early years in Delhi before moving to Bengaluru when his father was appointed Director of the Indian Institute of Horticultural Research. Joining St Joseph's Boys' High School in Standard 8, he completed his schooling in 1969. He went on to graduate in Agricultural Sciences, excelling not just academically but also on the sports field earning University Blues in both Tennis and Hockey.

Until 1993, Gurmeet worked in tea estates, landscaping, and pest control services. His journey into social service began in 1988 when he joined the Rotary, actively participating in community initiatives. But 1993 became a turning point, a year when Gurmeet's vision and compassion crystallized into a mission that would change countless lives.

That year marked the founding of Karunashraya – "The Abode of Compassion" – India's first stand-alone hospice for terminally ill cancer patients. Established on a 5-acre government-leased plot in Bengaluru, Karunashraya offers 73 in-patient beds and three home care teams, providing completely free palliative care to over 30,000 patients and their families. Recognizing that the final days of life are often marked by neglect, isolation, and despair, Gurmeet dedicated himself to ensuring that patients are treated with dignity, compassion, and comfort.

Under his leadership as Managing Trustee, Karunashraya has grown into a national leader in palliative care. A second centre – the Bagchi Karunashraya Palliative Care Centre – with 110 beds has recently been established in Bhubaneswar, Odisha, with Gurmeet at the helm of its planning and operations. Today, the Karunashraya Institute for Palliative Care, Education and Research is also a recognized PhD centre. Importantly, the organization receives no government funding and relies entirely on donations from individuals, other trusts, and CSR contributions, with Gurmeet's commitment and persuasive abilities ensuring the continued flow of resources.

His efforts have been widely recognised:

- Rajyotsava Award (2004) – Government of Karnataka.
- Service Above Self Award (2013) – Rotary International.

Beyond Karunashraya, Gurmeet's contributions to the St Joseph's Boys' High School Old Boys' Association (OBA) have been significant. As OBA President from 2001–2004, during the school's reconstruction phase, he played a pivotal role in raising funds, supporting the Jesuit administration, especially Principal Fr. Michael John and launching the Teachers' Insurance Scheme. In 2019, as Chief Election Officer, he oversaw a smooth, controversy-free election process. He remains a regular at OBA annual meetings and is a consistent contributor to the Teachers' Health Insurance Fund maintained by the Class of 1969.

Gurmeet comes from a family of achievers: his father was the Founder Director of the Indian Institute of Horticultural Research and Captain of the Indian Men's Hockey Team (1952–55). Gurmeet is married to Annie, sister of Ittira Davis (Class of 1969, Captain of St George's), and together they have a son, a legal consultant, and two daughters in the

education sector. Known for their warmth and hospitality, Gurmeet and Annie have hosted numerous batch reunions at their home.

Soft-spoken, gracious, and respectful of differing opinions, Gurmeet Singh Randhawa stands as an exemplar of the Josephite spirit, a life devoted to service, compassion, and the cause of "Dignity in Dying and Death."

Dr. Pretesh Rohan Kiran

Alumnus – St Joseph's Boys' High School, Class of 1994

Dr. Pretesh Rohan Kiran, a proud Josephite from the Class of 1994, completed his MBBS from Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences, Bengaluru in 2001. He began his career serving at the CSI Redfern Memorial Hospital, a rural mission hospital in Hassan, for two years. In 2007, he earned his MD in Community Health from St John's Medical College, Bengaluru, followed by a Postgraduate Diploma in Geriatric Medicine in 2010, the NMC Advanced Course in Medical Education in 2017, and a Distance Fellowship in Diabetology in 2024.

Since 2007, Dr. Pretesh has been a faculty member in the Department of Community Health at St John's Medical College, where he also serves as a Community Geriatrician, Disaster Health professional, and faculty in the Department of Medical Education.

As a public health specialist, he has contributed extensively to undergraduate and postgraduate training at St John's and beyond. Over the past two and a half decades, he has worked on numerous national and international initiatives in geriatrics and disaster health. He played a key role in establishing the Senior Citizen Health Service at St John's, which delivers care to the elderly, in rural and urban underprivileged communities, old age homes, and through domiciliary visits in and around Bengaluru.

In disaster relief, Dr. Pretesh has led, coordinated, and conducted assessments in over 20 major relief operations across India since 2000. He has served on national and international advisory boards, contributed to training programs, and provided academic input to a wide range of professional fields. His policy contributions include being part of the Karnataka Knowledge Commission expert team in drafting the Karnataka State Health Policy in both 2016 and 2022.

Dr. Pretesh's work has been recognised with numerous awards:

- Vayoshreshtha Samman (2021) – The highest Presidential award for senior citizen research and care, awarded by the Government of India for his work with the Senior Citizen Health Service.
- Young Scientist Award (2010) – Karnataka Association of Community Health.
- Covid Warrior Award – For contributions to pandemic response systems in Karnataka.
- Best Pilot Project in Elderly Care (2021) – Karnataka State Government, for the 'Grama Hiriyara Kendra' initiative.
- Member Exemplar Award (2023) – Catholic Club, for service to underprivileged and orphan children through the Catholic Club Orphans Trust since 2012.

As a faculty member of the Department of Medical Education – a nodal centre for the National Medical Council's medical education training, he has organised and facilitated numerous workshops and CMEs.

With over 60 scientific publications and more than 600 presentations at national and international forums, Dr. Pretesh has established himself as a respected voice in public health, geriatrics, and disaster medicine.

Beyond his professional achievements, he has been actively involved with St Joseph's Boys' High School for over 30 years, contributing to health initiatives for students and staff. Above all, he is known among his batchmates, teachers, and the wider community as a generous, compassionate, and dependable friend.
